We were taught many things here at the center. In my case they helped me to grow up as an individual, inside and outside of the institution, at work but also in my family life.

What soft skills have you acquired?

We had training sessions about how to express ourselves at work, how to present ourselves, how to get on well with our colleagues and to develop the ability to know new places and new professional options.

What learning tools have you used?

The courses have been virtual, mainly Elearning. We went on the internet, watched videos, and we also had more practical sessions with real life dynamics: games recreating what is the real working environment.

For me, this is such an interesting type of training, that I wonder...Why other people cannot have this type of training that I have had.

What skills have you used?

It has given me the opportunity and capabilities to find work and this has changed my life so much. I now have the joy of being able to work but also to work in something related to soldering and to the mechanical industry. When the grant was finished I was asked to stay at the enterprise that I was in.

Yes, the training has certainly helped me finding a job. The business built machines for the grain, rice, soya...It is related to the field of agriculture.

To have this job, which is stable, is very motivating for me in my life. I no longer depend on anyone. I depend on myself and my own job on the things that I do.
