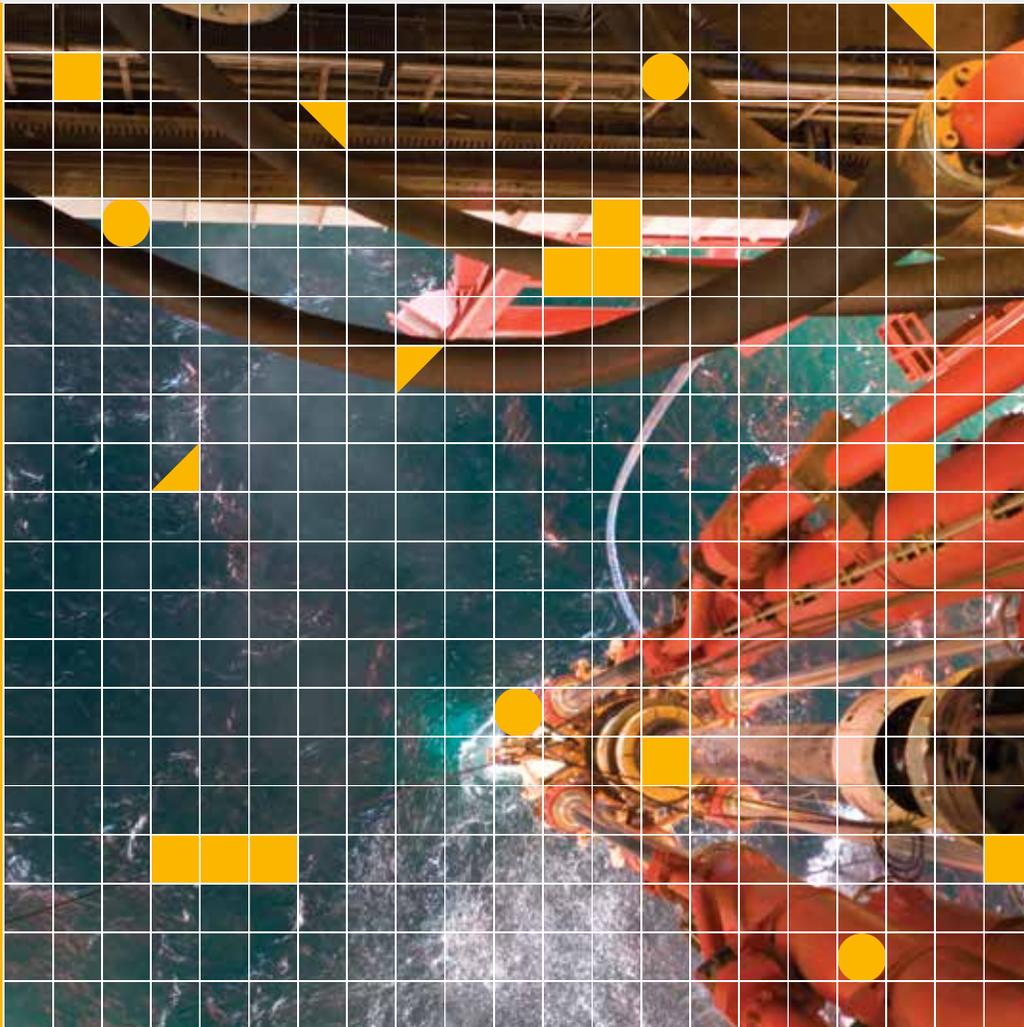


Accenture Upstream Production Operations Training for SAP

How will the training be delivered?

The first training sessions will be delivered as a mix of classroom-based sessions and self-paced eLearning modules (delivered through an Accenture online learning platform). Whether in person or online, all training is supported by job aids and quick reference materials.
