

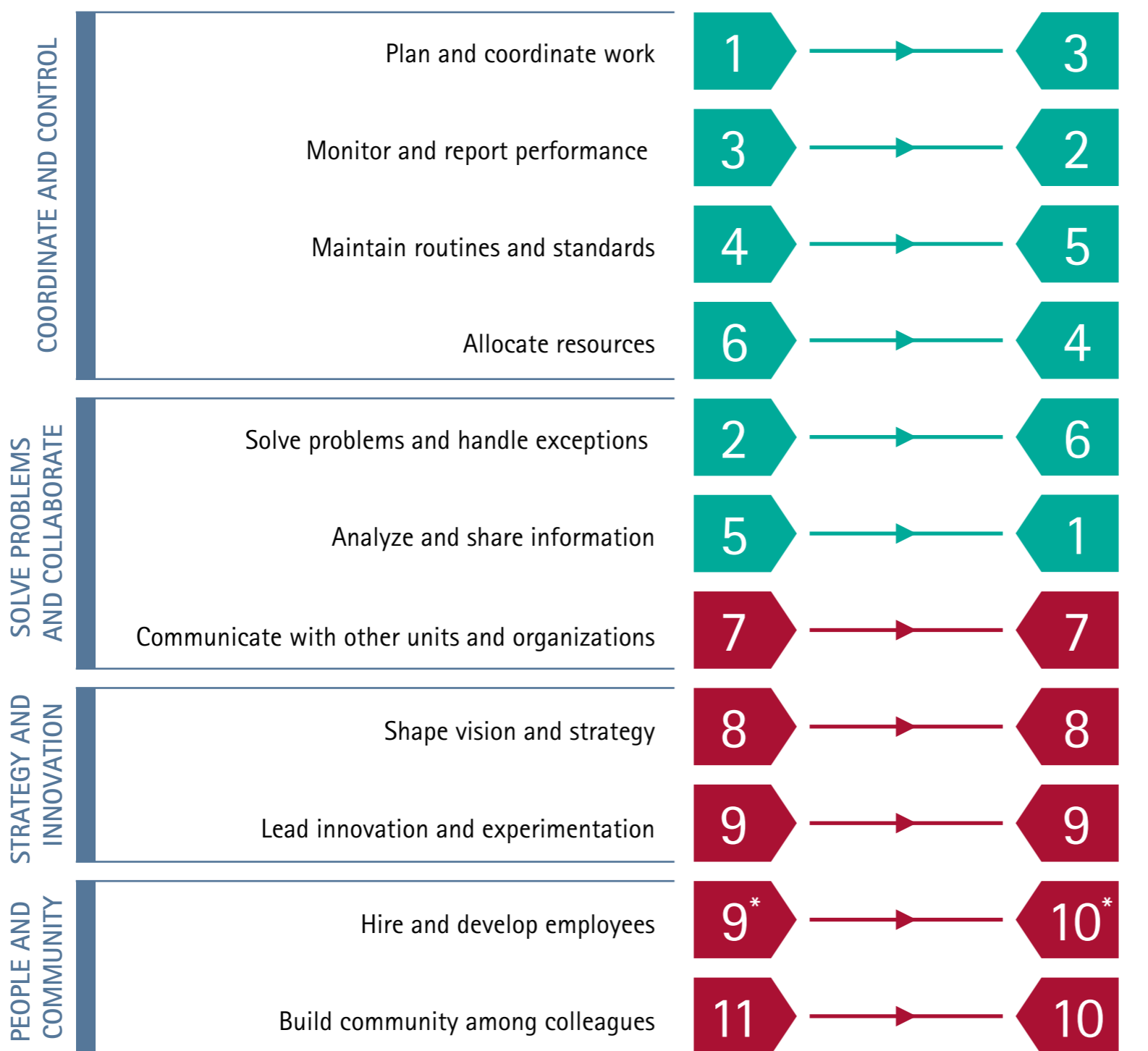
Ranking the expected impact of intelligent machines on key management tasks
