Today's digital technologies like EMR are helping doctors to deliver better healthcare and empowering patients with a more precise understanding of their personal health journey.

Accenture's recent surveys with both Doctors and Patients provide insights into the future of digital healthcare. EMR usage is on the rise. Globally, 80% of doctors surveyed engage EMRs more proficiently than two years ago, and one in three patients now use EMRs when managing their health.

Doctors and patients agree that the use of EMR improves provider-patient engagement. Surveyed Doctors believe that access to EMR improves patient satisfaction, understanding and communication.

And globally, approximately 3 in 4 patients surveyed believe it's important to have control of their health information.

And doctors also anticipate a positive impact of EMR usage on treatment decisions and health outcomes.

While current attitudes are positive, provider organisations predict improvements in EMR systems including better functionality & performance, built-in intelligence and integration across the care spectrum.
