

TOMÁS TOTH VIDEO TRANSCRIPT

My name is Tomáš. I work at Accenture as a Management Consultant. I've been with the company for six years. I spent the first two years at the Marketing Department while still a student. Afterwards, I wanted to choose something more business oriented. That's why I chose the opportunity to work at the Consulting Department.

Now I work in the Automotive Industry at the Connectivity Department, where we develop various use cases and utilizing the connection of a car to the internet, for example in online navigation or controlling the vehicle via a mobile application. We work with almost anything, but it mainly involves data analysis where we collect car-system data and then think up how we can use them in the future both for the customers and internally for the client. We also prepare frontends for the client. We develop applications, application design, and so on. My consulting day consists of making a list in the morning of important tasks that need to be done that day, I connect to the most important meetings either with a client or to an internal meeting. We prepare presentations which I then present to the management, or I calculate business cases for the client.

People on my team must be capable analysts and must be attentive to details. They must have mastery at least of English and be pro-client oriented. I currently work as a consultant, but every candidate also should experience the beginning position as an analyst. That is where the employee gets to know the project. He or she finds out how we work with the client and studies a whole lot of things, improves him or herself, makes presentations, and gradually climbs to higher positions. Then we have the role of consultant, who runs his or her own team and communicates directly with the client. One can then continue on to become a manager.

What especially keeps me at Accenture is the possibility to alternate between projects. You don't just sit in one chair for four years, but instead have the chance to take a look into other fields, too. You can try different projects, learn new things. Another reason is the opportunity for training. Accenture provides trainings in various topics and also abroad. Lastly, Accenture offers the chance to travel, because it has offices all over the world. That means it's no problem to participate in training or visit a client in another part of Europe.
